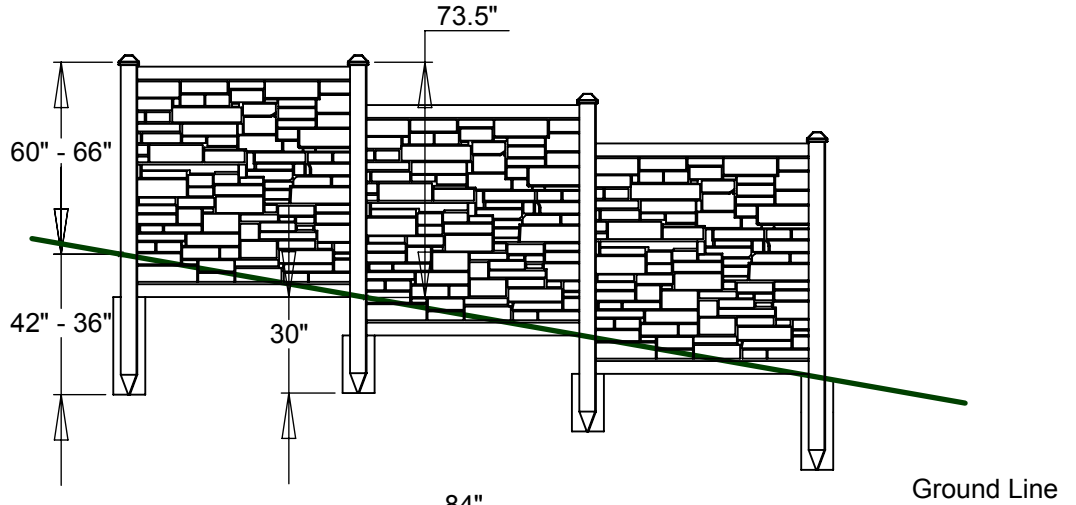


Installation on Sloping Terrain 6'

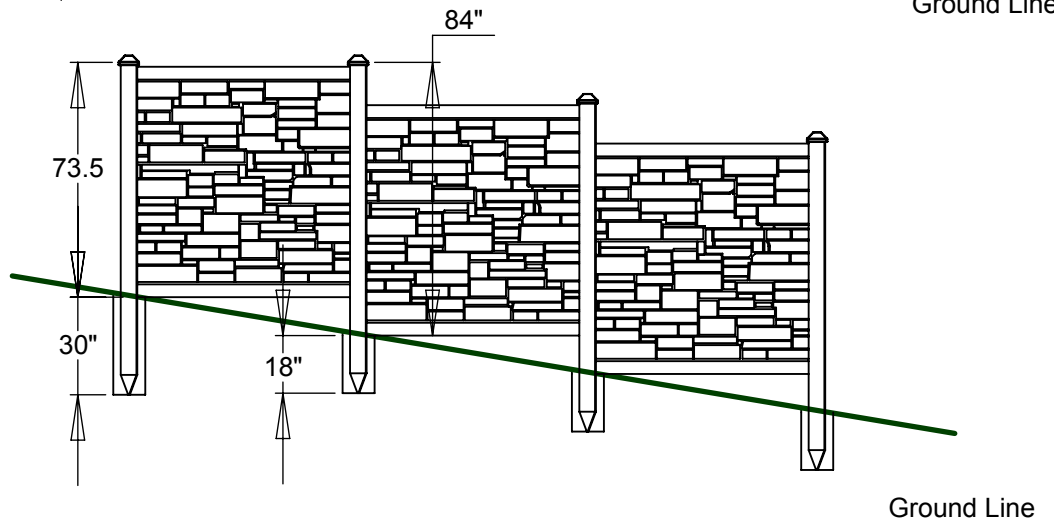
No Gap

The highest point of a stepped panel can be buried to eliminate a gap. This will reduce the height of the fence at the highest point.



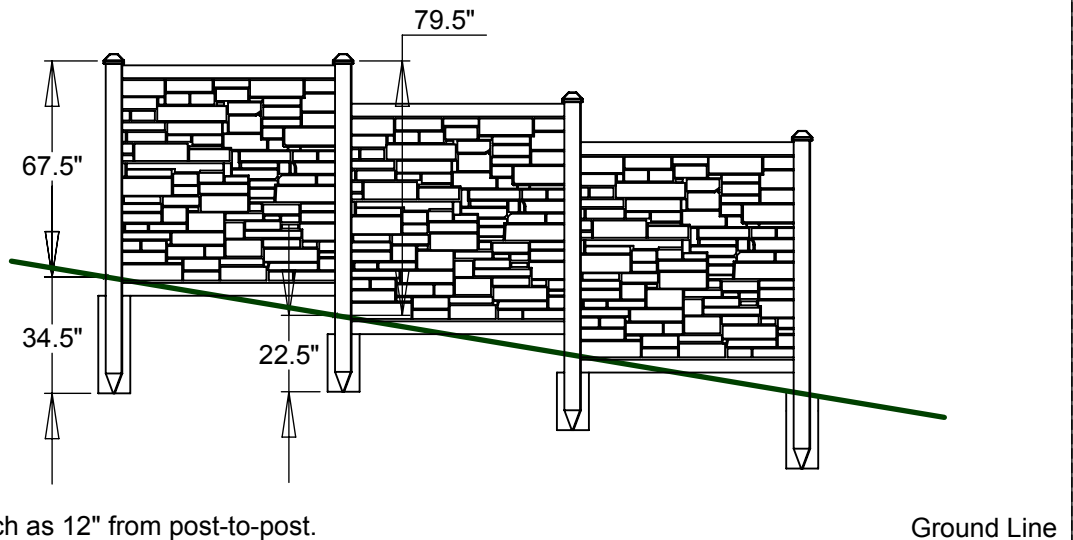
Gap

The highest point of a stepped panel can be set at ground level. This will leave a growing gap from post-to-post.




Small Gap

The highest point of a stepped panel can be partially buried to minimize the gap. This will reduce the height of the fence at the highest point by a few inches.



Notes:

- 1) A panel can be stepped as much as 12" from post-to-post.
- 2) For steeper elevations you can use a 142" post.
- 3) SimTek Fence is not engineered to be used as a retaining wall.
